## Keyboard

The standard American QWERTY keyboard upgraded with a phonetic Russian layout and additional German characters allows you to enter any word just in seconds.

Each national character set is linked to its input mode, indicated in the screen's upper right-hand corner by capital letters E, R, or G. Input modes can be switched consecutively in the above sequence by pressing the ⇔ key. In the main dictionary, however, the input mode selection is handled automatically to comply with the current source language, and the ⇔ key is used for changing the translation direction.

To enter Russian letters Ю, Ъ or German letters Ä, Ö, Ü, ß, press and release SHIFT prior to pressing the corresponding letter key.

The function and control keys are described below.



**Icons Menu**

The Language Teacher® EGR486T features a new start-up interface with two sets of functional icons, which visually organize and facilitate access to the dictionary's multiple sections.

The *Icons Menu* appears after a system initialization, upon pressing the MENU key, or whenever you exit a section by pressing the ESC key. The first set of icons includes, from left to right, top to bottom: *Dictionary, Grammar, TOEFL, Idioms, Irregular Verbs, User's Dictionary, Dialogs, Game Center, World Time, Local Time.*



The second set of icons contains: *Telephone Directory, Memo, Schedule, Calendar, Calculation, Metric Conversion, Currency Exchange, Sentence Translation, PC-Link, Setup Main Menu.*



- To display the *Icons Menu*, press MENU.
- Alternate between the two sets of icons by pressing the ▲ or ▼ key.
- Use arrow keys to highlight icons.
- Press ENTER to open the section whose icon is highlighted.

In addition, icons of each set\* are numbered from 1 to 0 to allow for the selection to be made also by pressing a corresponding number key on the keyboard.

## **POWER SUPPLY**

The Language Teacher® EGR486T is powered by two (2) AAA batteries. When the batteries become weak, you will see the message "Low Battery Voltage. Turn off the machine".

In order to prevent an excessive discharge of batteries and resulting loss of data in RAM, the dictionary turns itself off automatically and cannot be used until you install a new set of batteries. Replace the complete set of batteries promptly. Do not mix old and new batteries.

- Press the ON/OFF key to turn the unit off.
- Remove the battery compartment cover by sliding it away from the unit.
- Remove the used batteries and replace them with new ones.
- Make sure to place the batteries according to the polarity markings (+ -) inside the compartment.
- Put back the battery compartment cover by sliding it toward the translator. Make sure the cover sits in place properly.

\* Captions and symbols at number keys refer only to options of the first *Icons Menu*.

- ◆ **Note:** After replacing the batteries, if the prompt SYSTEM INITIALIZATION. PRESS (Y/N) appears on the screen, press the N key to retain user's data in RAM.
- ◆ **Note:** After purchasing the Language Teacher® EGR486T remove the insulation stripe from the battery compartment. It was installed to prevent the discharge of batteries during storage and transportation.
- ◆ **Note:** Never try to remove batteries from the translator when the power is on. This can seriously damage the device. If you experience difficulty turning the unit off, press the RESET button on the back side of the unit and reinstall the system.
- ◆ **Note:** A compact CR1220 battery is used for memory backup. It is recommended to replace it once a year.
- ◆ **Note:** The Language Teacher® EGR486T is equipped with a jack for external power supply. Contact your dealer to order a compatible AC/DC adapter or call 1-800-710-7920 within the continental US, 812-545-3838 in Russia, or 30-8950-3535 in Germany. **Use of an inappropriate external power supply may cause failure of the unit and void the warranty.**

- Press the SETUP key or choose  on the second *Icons Menu* to display the *Main Setup Menu*.

- Press the H key on the keyboard, or highlight the *Display Language* line using the arrow keys and press ENTER.

### **A. Real Time Clock Setup**

- On the *Setup Main Menu*, press the A key to enter the *Real Time Clock* setup, or make sure the corresponding line is highlighted and press ENTER.



- Enter the date and time by pressing appropriate number keys on the keyboard. For example, to enter October 15, 1999, 1:25: Press . 4 times to bypass the year, then press in sequence 1, 0, 1, 5, 0, 1, 2, 5. If you are using the 12-hour American time format, specify PM by pressing the P key or AM by pressing the A key.
- Press ENTER to display the *Set Local Time* screen.

Specify a city or country. New York is chosen by default.  
To set, for example, Atlanta:

- Press the L key for city. *Abu Dhabi, UAE* appears on the screen. Press the . key until you reach *Atlanta, USA*. Or,
- Press U for country, using the ▼ key page down to US cities and further until Atlanta.
- ♦ **Note:** Pressing the . or . key lists all cities, pressing the ▼ or ▲ key lists cities within each country, all in alphabetical order.



The number at the bottom indicates the difference between local time and GMT. For Atlanta the difference is -5 hours.

- Press ENTER. The next screen you see is




You may use your Language Teacher® as a talking clock (default setting). Every time you select  from the first *Icons Menu* you will hear the current time announcement.

- To disable or re-enable the announcement of time, use the . or ENTER key.
- Press ESC to return to the *Setup Main Menu*.

## ***B. Daily Alarm Setup***

- On the *Setup Main Menu*, press the B key to enter the *Daily Alarm* setup, or highlight the corresponding line and press ENTER.




- Enter time using the . and number keys. When you reach the PM/AM field for the 12-hour time format, press A for AM or P for PM. You may need to press the ENTER key to switch to the next screen.



- Press the . key to activate the daily alarm. A small bell sign appears on the display's bottom line. If you want to disable the alarm, press . again and the bell sign disappears from the screen.
- Press SHIFT+SETUP to leave the *Daily Alarm* setup and enter the *Setup Main Menu*.

### **C. Display Format Setup**

- On the *Setup Main Menu*, press the C key to enter the *Display Format* setup, or highlight the corresponding line and press ENTER.




The military 24-hour month/day/year format is chosen by default in the system.

- Press ENTER with the highlight bar on the first line if you want to select the 12 hour AM/PM format. A check mark appears next to the 12 hour option. Move the highlight bar down with the . key to the day/month/year line and press ENTER if you wish to choose this date format.
- Press SHIFT+SETUP to leave the *Display Format* setup and enter the *Setup Main Menu*.

#### **D. Keytone On/Off Setup**

- On the *Setup Main Menu*, press the D key to enter the *Keytone On/Off* setup, or highlight the corresponding line and press ENTER.



This feature is designed to produce a short audible signal every time you press a key on the Language Teacher®'s keyboard. The keytone is enabled by the system's default.

- Use an arrow key to move the highlight bar between ON and OFF.
- Press ENTER to confirm your setting.
- Press SHIFT+SETUP to leave the *Keytone On/Off* setup and enter the *Setup Main Menu*.

### **E. Speech Frequency Setup**


- Press the E key to enter the *Speech Frequency* setup, or highlight the corresponding line and press ENTER.



- Press the . or . key to change the frequency of speech.
- Press the  key to test the setting.
- Press ENTER to leave the *Speech Frequency* setup and return to the *Setup Main Menu*.


### **F. Secret On/Off Setup**

- Press the F key to enter the *Secret On/Off* setup, or select the corresponding line and press ENTER.

- Type in your password. The length of the password cannot exceed 7 characters, English letters only. For example, type "LOCK".
- Press ENTER. A confirmation message is displayed.

- Press ENTER to leave the *Secret On/Off* setup and return to the *Setup Main Menu*.
- To activate the password, re-select the option *Secret On/Off* on the *Setup Main Menu*.

- Press the 1 key. The message "SECRET ON" is displayed for a second and a key icon appears on the screen's bottom line. Now all marked records can only be seen if the password protection is disabled.

- ◆ **Note:** For more information about how to mark records to protect your private data refer to the sections *Telephone Directory*, *Memo*, and *Schedule*.
- To turn off the password protection, re-select the option *Secret On/Off* on the *Setup Main Menu*.

- Type your password in the brackets and press ENTER. The message "SECRET OFF" is displayed for a second and the key icon disappears from the screen. Now you may view and edit all of your secret records.
- ◆ **Note:** Always remember your password. If you forget your password, you will need to reset the dictionary, which might lead to the loss of all data stored in RAM.
- To clear or change the password, re-select the option *Secret On/Off* on the *Setup Main Menu*.

## DICTIONARY

The integrated Digital Language Learning System Language Teacher® EGR486T contains the most advanced bilingual English-German-Russian electronic dictionaries available on the market. In order to fully utilize the tremendous potential of this dictionary, carefully read this section of the User's Guide.

### **General Dictionary Function**

- Press the ON/OFF key to turn the dictionary on.
- Press the DICT key or choose  on the first *Icons Menu* to enter the main dictionary.
- On the displayed input screen, select a language pair and the direction of translation.
- ♦ **Note:** Press the DICT key repeatedly to alternate between the English-Russian, English-German, and Russian-German dictionaries. Use the ⇔ key to reverse the translation direction in the chosen language pair.
- Using the keyboard, enter the word you want to translate.

Suppose you want to translate the English *verb* CATCH into Russian.



- Press ENTER. You will see translations of the *noun* CATCH.

- ◆ **Note:** Headwords with the same spelling are listed in the alphabetical order of the abbreviations of their respective parts of speech.
- To translate another word in the same dictionary, start typing, and the input screen appears automatically.
- To change the direction of translation, use ESC to return to the input screen, then press the ⇔ key.
- To change the language pair, press DICT on the input screen.

## Advanced Word Recognition


Your Language Teacher® EGR486T is equipped with an *Advanced Word Recognition* feature. While you are typing, a word closest in spelling to the portion you entered so far is displayed on the screen's bottom line. If the desired word had appeared before you finished typing, press ENTER to see its translations.

- Start typing the word RECOGNITION.

When you reach the letter O, the desired word is shown on the bottom line.



- Press ENTER.



- ◆ **Note:** Proper usage of this function allows you to accelerate your work effectively while translating large texts.


## Spelling Checker Vector Ultima™

The trilingual English/Russian/German spelling checker Vector Ultima™ is one of the most advanced on the market. It allows you to enter words as you hear them and disregard the spelling.


- Type the word DAUGHTER as you hear it.



- Press the SPELLER key. A list of suggestions appears on the screen.



- Press the . key once to highlight the word DAUGHTER.
- Press ENTER to see the first entry for this word.



- Press the ▼ key to see the translation of the *noun* DAUGHTER.

### ***Pronunciation of Words and Sentences***

One of the most exciting features of the Language Teacher® EGR486T is the T-T-S (text to speech)-based pronunciation of English, Russian, and German words and phrases.

- On the input screen select, for example, the English-German dictionary by using the DICT and ⇔ keys.
- Enter APPOINT and press ENTER to display the translations.

- Press the  key to listen to the pronunciation of the English headword.

- Press SHIFT +  to listen to the pronunciation of all displayed translations.
- ◆ **Note:** T-T-S is able to generate pronunciation of any English, Russian, or German text, not limited to dictionary entries. Simply type a word or phrase on the input screen of the corresponding dictionary and press  to listen to its pronunciation. For example, type “BROOKLYN BRIDGE” in the English-Russian or English-German dictionary, press  and listen to its English pronunciation.
- ◆ **Note:** Using the *Setup Main Menu* you may adjust the frequency and speed of the speech shaping your own pronunciation style.
- ◆ **Note:** The Language Teacher® EGR486T is equipped with a volume control switch and an earphone jack, located on the translator’s right-hand and left-hand edge, respectively. By plugging in the earphone you disconnect the built-in speaker. Pull the earphone connector out of jack to re-activate the speaker’s function.

## GRAMMAR

The Language Teacher® EGR486T offers a section of English and German Grammar programmed into the electronic device. A supplemental book written by Prof. Max Sukhan, which explains difficult parts of English and German grammar to Russian speakers, is included in the package.

- Select  on the first *Icons Menu* to access the *Grammar* directory.



- ◆ **Note:** You may listen to the pronunciation of the examples displayed on the screen by pressing the  key.

## TOEFL

The Language Teacher® EGR486T “Professional” contains a practical preparation guide for the *Test of English as a Foreign Language* (TOEFL), which is required of non-native English speakers as part of the admission procedure to an American college. This section offers you a unique opportunity to practice a computerized test version as it is likely to be presented to you at a real examination.

- Select  on the first *Icons Menu* to access the *TOEFL* menu.



The *Tutorial* provides you with general information about the requirements, structure, and duration of a TOEFL test. The *Tutorial* text is available in English, German, and Russian. These options can be selected from the *Tutorial* submenu.

- Select the option *Tutorial* on the *TOEFL* menu and choose the language you want to read the *Tutorial* in.
- Read the *Tutorial*, using **..** for scrolling by line, **◆** for paging.

After you become acquainted with the *TOEFL* basics set forth in the *Tutorial*, you might feel prepared to practice in answering questions. For your convenience, sample questions are arranged in two sequences, represented by the options *Sample Tests* and *Sample Exercises*.

- Select the option *Sample Tests* on the *TOEFL* menu to open its submenu, which includes four tests options.

Each test contains Multiple Choice questions pertaining to all three sections of a standard *TOEFL*, which are referred to under the names: *Listening Comprehension*, *Structure and Grammar*, *Reading Comprehension*.

- Select the option *Sample Exercises* on the *TOEFL* menu to open its submenu, which includes three options corresponding to the sections of *TOEFL*.

The *Sample Exercises* option allows you to practice each of the three sections of the *TOEFL* test separately. The questions from the four available *Sample Tests* are rearranged depending on which section of the test they belong to. The sections are further subdivided into two or three parts comprising questions of the same type. For example, parts of *Structure and Grammar* are *Sentence Completion* and *Error Identification*:



- By selecting the *Toefl Help* option you can obtain detailed directions for the types of exercises included in the current menu.

Regardless of which practice form you have chosen, each sample question is structured as follows:

- Question text (not displayed in the *Listening Comprehension* section )
- Four answer versions lettered A, B, C, D, immediately following or included in the question text
- Answer selection line at the bottom of the screen

- Use or . . for scrolling.
- Press the M key to display a pop-up menu, which includes the options:
  - A. Say hidden text
  - B. Show hidden text

- ◆ **Note:** The options *Say hidden text* and *Show hidden text* only work with questions from the *Listening Comprehension* section, and are disabled elsewhere.
- Select *Say hidden text* to hear a *Listening Comprehension* question text again
- Select *Show hidden text* to display a *Listening Comprehension* question text
- Select *Show right answer* to see the correct answer

---

\* The questions of the *Listening Comprehension* section, instead, are *spoken out* for you while only answers are displayed.

- ◆ **Note:** Use these options only for self-checking: *Say hidden text*, *Show hidden text* and *Show right answer* are promptings that must be resorted to as sparingly as possible since they will not be available during a real test.
- To jump to a specific question, select *Go to* and specify a question number
- Select an answer by highlighting the corresponding letter on the bottom line with the .. keys.
- To go to the next question, press SHIFT + ▼. In the *Sample Exercises* section, a message appears momentarily telling you whether your answer was right or wrong.

When you return to the TOEFL menu, a message box is shown, which includes information on the total number of questions, number of correct answers, and your score, which is based on a formula used for real TOEFL tests.

### Scope Input

- ◆ **Note:** If (T) is selected as a *Var express* value on the *Mode* menu (see below), then *Tmin*, *Tmax* define the variation limit. *Tstep* is the drawing precision. It represents an X-value and an Y-value per a *Tstep*.
- Press ENTER on the last line to save the values and return to the *Graphic Calculator* menu.

## Mode Setup

- Select the option *C. Mode* on the *Graphic Calculator* menu.  
To set a value in one of the four options, highlight it and press ENTER.
- Customize your graph using the drawing *Modes*:  
*Angle show*: with *Axle express* set to ARC\_AXLE, choose an angle measurement unit.




Using the Language Teacher®'s PC-Link cable (to be purchased separately) and the LT *PC-Link* software for Windows 95/98/NT (included with the package) you may exchange data between your Language Teacher® EGR486T and a personal computer.

### Software

- Insert the supplied CD into the CD-ROM drive of your PC.
- If the installation didn't start automatically, execute the file Setup.exe.
- Follow the instructions on the screen.

### Data Exchange

- Connect the cable to the *PC-Link* outlet located on the right-hand edge of the unit.
- Press the  key on the Language Teacher®'s keyboard or choose  on the second *Icons Menu*.



- Select a data transfer mode, for example, *Transmit*.
